Whaleback Disc Golf Park

Thanks to the unrelenting efforts of Darrell Chipp and the Bay St George Disc Golf Association, the first season of the Whaleback Disc Golf Park was hugely successful. With lots of support from the Town of Stephenville and many community sponsors, the course received hundreds of

plays each month and was ready to host provincials in September. Combined with planned work as a result of an Active Living Grant received in the spring, the development of the course has greatly improved the Foxtrot trail. I've lost count of the loads of fill that were spread on the trail! There were also culverts installed and a good amount of brush clearing. I've got to say that disc golf is such a fun way to enjoy our trails in the off-season. Just ask Bruce!



Trail Improvements

As mentioned above, the Foxtrot had a lot of TLC this summer that has already proven beneficial given the number of skiers out last weekend when we had an early snowfall! I'd like to highlight a few other organizations that contributed:

- Marine Contractors and Glynn Pike for the generous donation of ClassB fill.
- The Town of Stephenville for donating culverts and Eddy Services for transporting them to the ski trails. Thanks also to Mike Whalen and Johnnie White for making this happen.

Work was also completed on a couple of downhill turns on Braveheart (pictures below) and it should be very safe and skiable in all conditions. The stumps have been removed on Heart Rate Hill and we installed a culvert at the top of Heart Rate Hill. Finally, Olivers Twist (a fan favorite!) had some leveling done by an excavator.

Another change you'll notice this year is new signage on the trails. This initiative was made possible through an Active Living NL Grant and the efforts of Ivan MacDonald, Dave King and Doug Fowlow. Many people commented on the need for new signage in the survey so let us know what you think.

Early Bird Membership Prices

- Nordig Canada and CCNL have increased their fees by \$2-\$3 per person
- Our membership fees are inclusive of HST and Nordig Canada/CCNL fees
- If you select a family membership, enter the personal information for the first individual then click on Add Second Person. Enter the second person's information and in the Membership Type section choose Additional Family Member Ski/Snowshoe. Continue this process until all family members are entered.
- Payment methods include credit card through Zone4, debit card at the chalet or e-transfer to <u>whalebackskiclub@gmail.com</u>.

Cross Canada Challenge

We are challenging our entire membership to ski across Canada and back for a total of 15,000 kilometers. Details below. Thank you Bruce for leading this initiative, it's going to be fun!

- The event will run from January 1st to February 28th.
- Once you have skied 50kms you enter your name on the registration sheet posted in the chalet and record your kms.
- You will continue to record your distance in segments of 50kms.
- You may enter as an individual, with your skiing partner or as a family.
- A map of Canada will be posted in the chalet and updated regularly so everyone can see our progress. Maybe we'll "visit" some friends of the Whaleback along the way!
- Every participant will have their name entered for a chance to win a ski membership for next season.
- Limit of one entry per person.
- Everyone is encouraged to participate
